Embrace the NANETS Mission and Diversity Statement

- Keep our mission in mind as you do your work
- Use your role to affect change if it is needed

Show Your Leadership

- Lend your voice. At Board and committee meetings, share your thoughts and perspectives, especially as they relate to the mission, purpose, strategic direction, and goals of NANETS. The more we communicate: the more we will grow as an organization.
- Nominate people to serve. When you see that call for nominations, consider putting at least one person up for election.
- Mentor future leaders. We need to invest in the next generation of NANETS professionals.
- Encourage your colleagues to serve on committees. After you complete the committee interest survey, encourage others to do so as well.
- Keep diversity, equity and inclusion at the forefront of all NANETS' decision-making. Recognize who is in the room, and who would be valuable to invite into the conversation.
- Reach out to new members, trainees and invited guests when participating in NANETS related functions

- Attend our Symposia and Regional Conferences. Send your staff and trainees, and help spread the word to your colleagues.
